OUR CURRICULUM

GIS Primary runs an enhanced hybrid curriculum made up of the International Primary Curriculum (IPC), the British, and the Nigerian curricula.

This combination makes teaching and learning fun and effective at our campus. Furthermore, the rich program offers our pupils the opportunity to reach and surpass their potential.

The IPC delivers an education that involves tasks that are practical, investigative, and problem-solving. It also involves activities that are related to real-life situations. Mathematics

We take a holistic and integrated approach when teaching mathematics. Childrens' mathematical skills are developed through investigation, research, and projects that allow children to build a foundation of strong number sense and mathematical thinking.

English

In our English Language classes, pupils are immersed in hands-on and mental practices for the acquisition of writing, reading, and public speaking skills required of international learners.

Arts and Craft

We believe that the study of visual art helps learners with the development of motor skills, language skills, social skills, decision-making, risk-taking, and creativity.

Home Economics

Our Home Economics department is geared towards equipping pupils with life skills. Classes focus on the following areas - food and nutrition, home management, clothing and textiles, and consumer education.

The Sciences

We take a practical approach to our physics, chemistry and biology lessons to make them more engaging for our students. For instance, we require every child to actively engage in hands-on science experiments to improve their scientific literacy.

Physical Education

Through a number of physical activities (e.g. track, badminton, and football), GIS Primary strives to instill essential life skills such as: discipline, leadership, team spirit, and communication. We also have highly trained teachers who act as coaches and instructors.

GIS Foreign Languages Department (French & Spanish)

The French and Spanish departments of GIS Primary organize educational excursions (both locally and internationally) to enhance and practicalize what our pupils learn within the four classroom walls of GIS.

The purpose of these excursions is for our pupils to further understand cultural diversity, while interacting with native speakers and enhancing their social skills. Furthermore, at the end of these excursions, our students are examined to ascertain their language proficiency - at the end of which, certificates are awarded.

Music department
